



Dear Parents,

First and foremost, we hope that you and your loved ones are safe and healthy. We have received questions from parents about if and how COVID-19 will affect First Baptist Church, Camp Sherwood. We know this pandemic has been stressful to many and recognize that socializing and interacting with peers can be a healthy way for children to cope with stress and connect with others, particularly after spending quite a bit of time at home. After careful thought and planning, we are excited to let you know that we plan to resume camp while following CDC considerations to protect campers, families, and our community.

The health and safety of our campers and staff remain our highest priority. Below, you will find a summary of actions we are taking to help ensure we are lowering COVID-19 risk as much as possible. We are limited to the number we can take this year (only). Therefore, there will be camp for those going into 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades in the Fall 2021. This is per Missouri State Park Guidelines:

There will be 3 girls/boys to a cabin plus a counselor. If your child wants to be in a cabin with certain people, please put that information on their application.

When you arrive at camp on July 25, 2021, you will check your child in. Unload the car in the parking lot. No parents are allowed in the units. We will be asking you to leave after you unload.

We cannot allow the parents to stay for the morning service or for lunch.

You need to get your application in as soon as possible as this is a **first come, first served year**.

All participants will be required to wear a mask to all camp activities. We will provide one mask. There will be paper masks available, or you may bring your own.

A handwash station will be set up by the Mess Hall for all to use on an ongoing basis.

Touchless hand sanitizing stations will be provided in front of the Mess Hall and Rec Hall.

Twice daily the restrooms, Mess Hall, and Rec Hall will be sanitized by use of a fogger.

All cabins will be sanitized with the fogger before campers arrive.

To eliminate overcrowding in the Mess Hall, we will be divided into 2 groups at each mealtime. This way, the Mess Hall will only be half full and we will use alternating tables for distancing. In our meeting/teaching area, chairs will be placed 6 feet apart.

**NO** visitors will be allowed into campground during the week.

Any equipment used during the day will be wiped with a sanitizing sheet.

Each morning the nurse(s) will take the temperature of the entire group.

If someone comes down with COVID within 7 days after camp week an e-mail/ mailing will be sent out to all those that attended camp.

## **Camp Check-Out**

All buildings used during our time at camp will be sanitized using a sanitizing fogger.

In the kitchen all surfaces will be wiped down with a sanitizing cloth/wipe.

If a camper or staff show symptoms, they will be isolated and evaluated. They may need to be tested for COVID-19.

If they are tested and the test is negative, they will continue at camp. If the test is positive, they will be sent home.

### **Driving Directions to Cuivre River State Park**

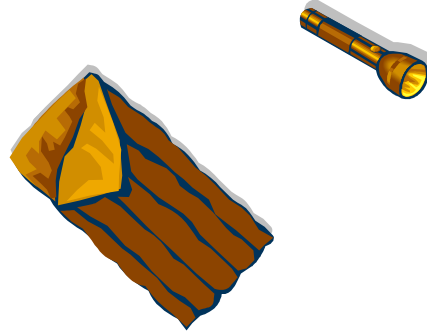
